

The Production of Dear Amelia



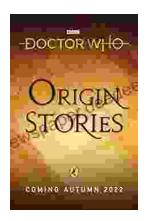
