ROAD MAP OF RUSSIA

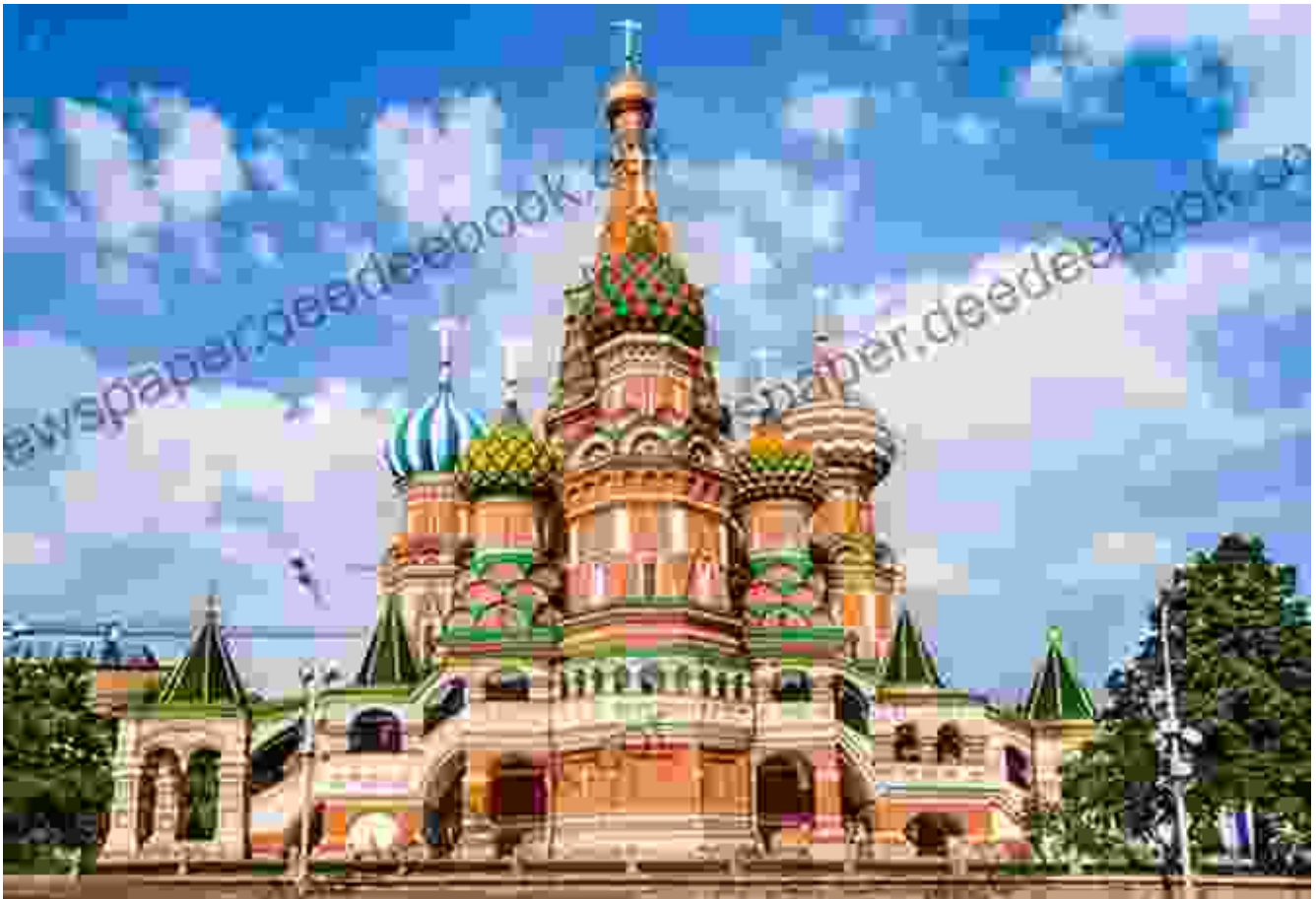

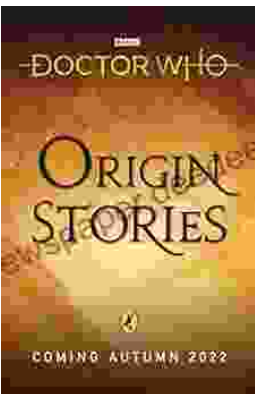
