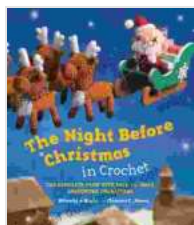
Basic Stitches

Basic Shapes

The basic shapes used in amigurumi are the circle, the square, and the triangle. To make a circle, start by making a magic ring. To make a square, chain four stitches and then turn and single crochet into each stitch across. Turn and repeat until the square is the desired size. To make a triangle,

chain three stitches and then turn and single crochet into each stitch across. Turn and repeat until the triangle is the desired size.

Joining Pieces

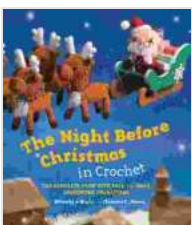
